"When I found out my pregnancy test was positive, I felt nervous—and especially scared to tell my parents. I had just graduated from high school two weeks before. Soon I would be starting classes at the Art Institute. I knew that they would be very disappointed in me.



I had already decided even before I went to Hope that if I was pregnant, an abortion would be the answer for me. I couldn't imagine where I would live or how I could support a baby financially.

After talking with the counselor at Hope, I was still leaning towards having the abortion. My boyfriend and I watched a video on how abortions were done, and I agreed to have an ultrasound to see how far along I was.

What an amazing experience! My baby was so big! I was 14 weeks along and I could see every part of her . . . hands and feet and her sweet little face . . . I told the nurse I was still undecided, but my heart was totally turned towards this little girl that was growing inside of me.

Jonathan and I decided to choose life for our daughter. We named her Faith, because it was faith that gave us the courage to become parents. For all of the fears we had about telling our families, they have both been so supportive!

I am thankful every day that Hope Women's Center was there for me. They told me the truth, wrapped in God's love. Their help has made a huge difference in our lives, and in the life of our precious baby girl."
